- 256 MB of RAM (higher recommended)
- IE 6.0 or Mozilla Firefox 1.5 or higher (browser must be Java and JavaScript enabled and have pop up blocker disabled)
- Internet access at 56k or higher (broadband strongly recommended)
- A sound card and speakers. A video camera is optional, but recommended for synchronous online classes that use Voice Over IP.
