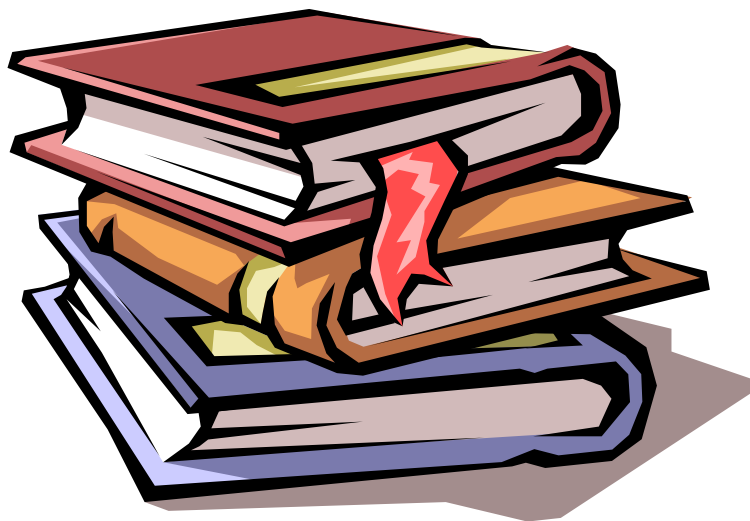

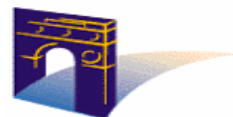


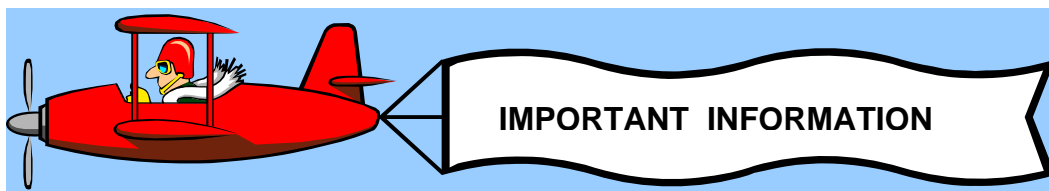

Tuition and Fees Information:

- If you were enrolled for the Spring 2009 semester, there is a nonrefundable registration and services fee of \$294 for the first credit, plus \$58 for each additional credit.
